Isaiah 45:1, 4-6

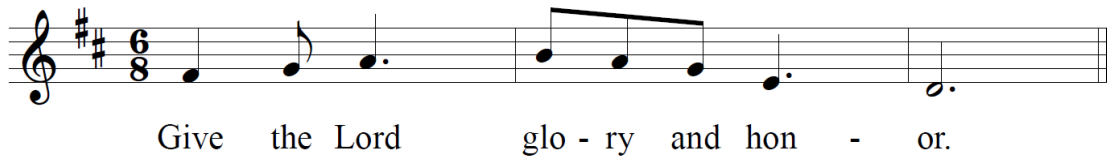
Thus says the LORD to his anointed, Cyrus,

and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and life of the world to come. Amen.


