NIGHT AT THE RACES - IT IS GOING TO BE A BLAST!!!

We are happy to announce our “**Night at the Races**” – Saturday November 8, 2025. In addition to being a fundraiser for Immaculate Conception Parish it will be a great night out!

Following is an outline of the night’s events so you can be sure of what to expect.

Registrants will receive one admission ticket, the ownership of a horse or jockey, great food, drinks and dessert – at a cost of \$25.00. The horse owners are entitled to the naming of a horse and have it entered into one of the 9 races for the evening. Each race will have ten horses running for the roses!

NOTE: Once 90 horses have been sold the names of additional horses will become jockeys.

The winner of the race entitles the owner(s) to win the **\$50** prize for that race! Each race will be displayed on the TV screens in the hall and the race will be called “live” by our professional caller. He will provide 25 DVD races chosen randomly by one of our guests. The winner is disclosed only to the caller.

Placing Bets

Even though you may not be an owner of a horse or jockey in a particular race everyone is welcome to lay as many bets on whatever horse and jockey you fancy. Maybe you will bet on your friend’s horse or jockey or a name that “sounds” like a winner! All bets will be taken at the betting windows and then the race is run. The odds will be figured out based on how many have bet on the winning horse and jockey leaving of course the house a purse as well. The winners will be notified of the payout and will pick up their winnings at the payout window. Then the windows will be open for the next race!

Other games of chance and other prizes!

Throughout the night there will be a 50/50, paint sticks, and basket auction tickets.

The Food Menu - There will be plenty of great food and of course dessert. The thirst for beer and soda will be satisfied! You can bring your own favorite snacks or beverages to share with your friends at your table.

Auction Race – At the end of the 9 races the excitement is only to begin when bets are taken for the auction race! Ten Horses will be auctioned off to the highest bidder. Usually these horses are sold for well over \$100 which allows whole groups of people to pool their money to buy a horse. The winnings will be a straight 50-50 split with the house. It is very realistic to win over \$500 in this race!
